FOR SAFETY &

PLOWING:

NO OVERNIGHT PARKING IS PERMITTED ON RESIDENTIAL STREETS!

SNOWPLOWING PRIVATE DRIVES:

CRV is no longer plowing private drives unless there is a risk to avoid injury to person or property. Salted sand may be picked up at the maintenance building, in a small (5-gallon pail) at no charge.

Wood burning and Recreational

Fires are addressed in CRV Outdoor Burning Ordinance #16 found on the CRV website. An Outdoor Wood-Fired Hydronic Heater or Outdoor Wood Fired Furnace requires a Zoning Permit before installation.

ON Street Parking in South

Rushford is discouraged – it presents a public hazard on streets that are built to accommodate two-way traffic and snow plowing.

RENTALS:

Applications are available at the City Hall Office or online at www.rushfordvillage.govoffice.com
A \$50 DAMAGE DEPOSIT is required for all rentals as explained in the application.

Economic Development: The City of Rushford Village has a revolving loan fund that was created by repayments for Rushford Village Business Flood Loans. This is a "gap" financing that is available to existing and new CRV businesses when financing is needed beyond what a business' primary lender can provide. Contact the CRV Office for more information and/or application. Council approval will be required.

Utility Bills may be paid at Rushford State Bank. Please include your statement. To set up automatic payments, call your bank for assistance. **Non-sufficient fund check charge: \$25 charge.**

****Utilities may be shut-off for non-payment, unless you call the office in advance to set-up an acceptable payment arrangement! There will be an additional \$100.00 fee to turn your utilities back on.**

*Call for Zoning Permits. A permit is still required! **If you do not get a permit before starting the work, you will be charged a fine of \$250.00 plus double the original permit fee amount.***

Animal Control Ordinance: CRV Ordinance No. 1 prohibits dogs running at large & requires a leash or otherwise kept under control. **Always remember to pick up after your dog!**

Garbage Collection by HARTER'S TRASH & RECYCLING is Wednesday's (Thursday if a Holiday falls on Wed.) **Put garbage out Tuesday night or no later than 6:00 a.m. on Wednesday.** If your garbage tote is larger than needed, please ask to exchange for a smaller size to save costs for all taxpayers. There is no charge for 65 gallons, but \$10/Quarter for a 95-gallon tote. Place recyclables in paper bags or loose in recyclable container. Flatten cardboard boxes. Recycling reduces total collection charges paid through your taxes.
