

CITY OF RUSHFORD VILLAGE COLLECTION ORDINANCE
ORDINANCE NO. 2, AS AMENDED

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RUSHFORD VILLAGE REGULATING THE
COLLECTION OF UNPAID SERVICES AND OTHER CHARGES.

The City Council of Rushford Village, Fillmore County, Minnesota,
hereby ordains:

Section 1. That the City of Rushford Village provides certain services and/or contracts for certain services that are rendered for the health, welfare, and benefit of property owners in the City of Rushford Village.

Section 2. In the event the City of Rushford Village or agents of the City of Rushford Village provide any of the following services: municipal water or sewer, garbage collection, snow, ice or rubbish removal from private drives or sidewalks, weed elimination from streets or private property, removal or elimination of public health or safety hazards from private property, excluding any structure included under the provision of Sections 436.15 to 436.25, installation or repair of water service lines, street sprinkling or other dust treatment of streets, the trimming and caring of trees, and the removal of unsound trees from any street, the treatment and removal of insect-infested or diseased trees on private property, the repair of sidewalks and alleys, or the operation of a street lighting system or placement of road material on public or private property, and the charges for any of the aforementioned services have remained unpaid for a period of sixty (60) days on October 25th of any year, the City Council, by resolution duly enacted, may certify the unpaid charges with such fees as may apply to the Fillmore County Auditor as Special Assessments to be collected with real property taxes payable on such properties where such services were rendered.

Section 3. For purposes of implementing the provisions of this Ordinance, the owners of record shall be deemed to have contracted for the rendition and providing of services, whether or not the property is occupied by owner of record, or is occupied by a tenant(s).

Section 4. This Amended Ordinance shall become effective following its due passage and enactment and publication according to law. Passed and enacted this 15th day of December, 1994, on motion by Paul Sorum, seconded by Gordon Johnson and carried unanimously.
